THE RAILROAD PHOTOGRAPHS OF PRESTON GEORGE

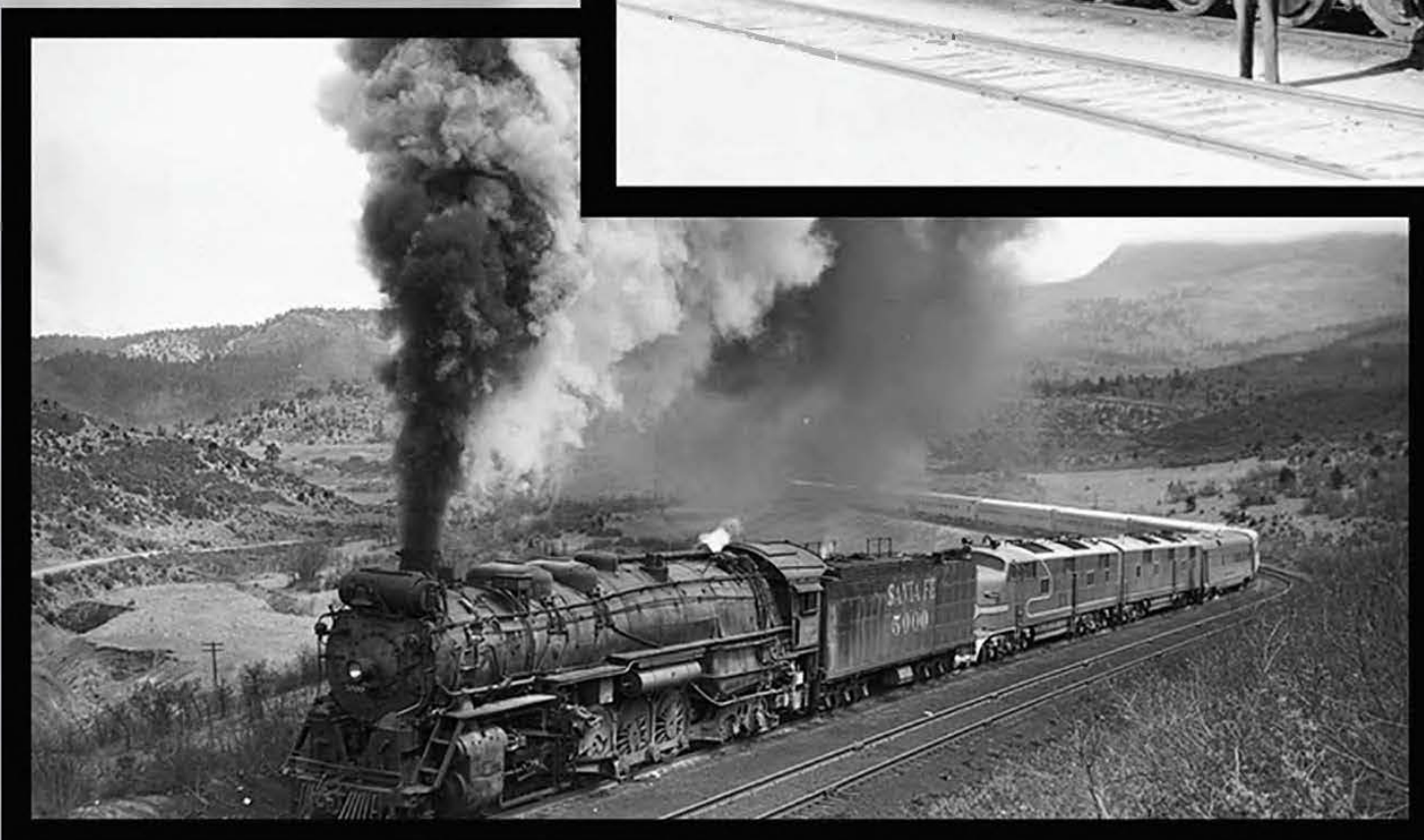
