## Indian Allotments Information Sources

If you know the individual's name, search the [Index to Early Oklahoma Land Tract Books F693 O42 I53](#).

If you do not know the individual's name search the following resources:

The 1900 US Oklahoma Territory Census and the 1910 US Oklahoma Census often list the township in which the person lived at the time of the census. Researchers can use Oklahoma county township maps to identify the township and range of that municipal township within the county.

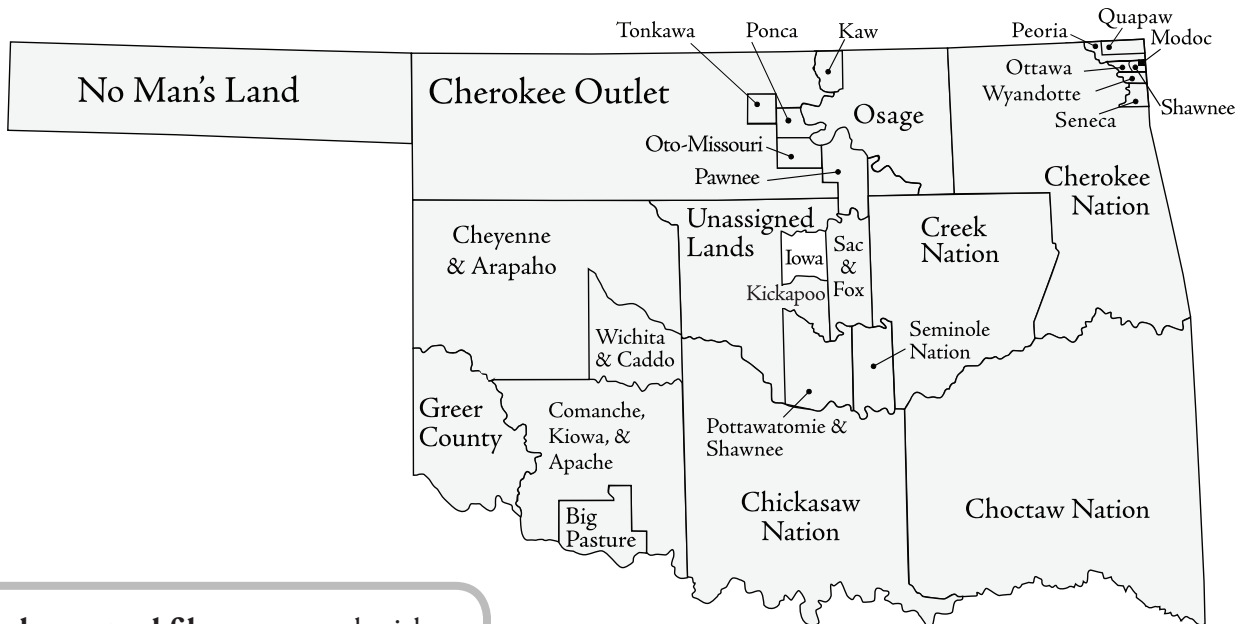

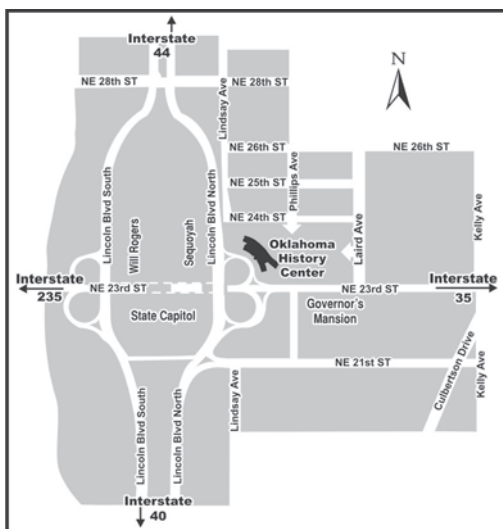
