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Abstract

In January 2002, the City of Guthrie retained the services of Preservation Central, Inc., a historic preservation consulting firm based in Austin, Texas, to conduct an architectural survey of the East Guthrie Townsite. Preservation Central, Inc. surveyed 849 cultural resources, regardless of age, architectural or historical merit, or condition, within the East Guthrie Townsite, an area bounded by College Avenue on the north, the creek south of Lincoln Avenue on the south, Division Street on the west and Walnut Street on the east. Of the 849 resources surveyed, 762 were dated to the historic period i.e., they were 50 years old or older. Eighty-seven properties were found to be of more recent vintage, dating from 1955 to the present. Preservation Central used the date 1955 as the cut-off point for Contributing properties to assist in future planning purposes. Of the total surveyed resources, 532 were considered to be Contributing features of the historic district. Seventeen of those properties are considered to be of exceptional historical or architectural significance and are considered individually eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). Noncontributing properties were either modern resources or historic resources that lacked architectural integrity. There are 317 Noncontributing properties in the project area; 106 do not meet the age criterion and 211 are historic properties that have been significantly altered from their original or historic period appearance.

Statement of Intent

In the fall of 2001, the City of Guthrie, under the direction of the Guthrie Historic Preservation Commission, sought the services of qualified historic preservation consultants to update its inventory of cultural resources within the East Guthrie Townsite portion of the Guthrie Historic District. Previous cultural resources surveys in the Townsite were conducted in 1975 and 1987 in support of the Guthrie National Register District nomination. More recently, part of the project area was included in a 1999 National Historic Landmark nomination of the city's downtown commercial area. By pursuing an ongoing preservation program, the City of Guthrie acknowledges its unique contribution to Oklahoma's architectural heritage.

This survey, completed by Preservation Central, Inc., is part of the city's effort to support that program by compiling current and accurate information about East Guthrie's historic resources. Preservation Central, Inc. documented all properties within the project area boundaries at the minimum level by completing a "Historic Preservation Resources Identification Form" and taking at least two oblique photographs (whenever possible) showing three elevations for each resource. Based on their present condition, properties were reevaluated to assess their current Contributing/Noncontributing status within the Guthrie Historic District.

Introduction

The survey of East Guthrie's cultural resources (Documentation of Properties Within the East Guthrie Townsite of the Guthrie Historic District) is part of an ongoing program by the City of Guthrie and the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) to maintain current and accurate information about the city's historic resources in an effort to preserve and protect them. This survey resulted in a comprehensive inventory of all buildings, structures, objects and sites within the confines of the East Guthrie Townsite bounded by College Avenue on the north, the creek south of Lincoln Avenue on the south, Division Street on the west, and Walnut Street on the east. It is an update of earlier cultural resources surveys, the first of which was undertaken in 1975 as part of Guthrie Historic District National Register nomination. In 1987, Jane Thomas, a resident of East Guthrie, conducted an update of the 1975 survey.

In January 2002, the city of Guthrie retained Preservation Central, Inc., a historic preservation consulting firm based in Austin, to update the previous surveys conducted in 1975 and 1987 in the East Guthrie Townsite, an area encompassing all or part of 98 city blocks and containing more than 800 cultural resources. The Scope of Work for the current effort mandated that:

- all built resources in the project area regardless of age, condition, or architectural/historic merit would be surveyed at a minimal level.
- all surveyed resources would be assessed for their ability to contribute to the historic character of the district.
- the results of the survey and research would be compiled into a final report.
- individual files containing minimal survey information and photographs would be created for each surveyed resource

Preservation Central's survey teams minimally recorded and photographed 824 cultural resources – each building, structure, object or site – within the project area boundaries on three field trips during February, March and September, 2002.

Photographs of 29 additional properties were taken in February 2003. An individual

Historic Preservation Resource Identification Form created by the Oklahoma State
Historic Preservation Office was completed for each property and, in all but a handful of
cases, two oblique photographs were taken of each resource in an attempt to depict three
elevations of the property. In some instances, particularly in commercial zones where
buildings shared walls, it was impossible to capture three or even two elevations. In
those cases, every attempt was made to depict the resource in its physical context by
including a streetscape photograph containing the subject property.

Results of the survey found a total of 849 properties within the project area boundaries. Of that total, 532 were determined to be Contributing elements of the Guthrie Historic District and 317 were determined to be Noncontributing features of the district. Contributing elements of NRHP districts are recommended to be at least 50 years old and retain sufficient historic architectural fabric to be recognizable to their period of significance. Contributing properties of designated NRHP districts are considered to be significant cultural resources that are integral features of identified districts and thus, worthy of preservation. Some Contributing properties may be individually eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places by virtue of their architectural merit and/or exceptional historic significance. A list of these properties is included in the Recommendations section of this report. Noncontributing properties include both nonhistoric properties and historic period resources that have been extensively altered or that are incongruous with the historic character of the area due to a combination of their age, design or type.

Following the field work, photographs were processed, data encoded, and maps were made. Deliverables include 1) individual files for each of the 849 properties and 2) a survey report summarizing the results of the project. Each property file contains a completed inventory form with basic architectural information recorded and two or more black and white photographs showing three elevations of the individual resource. The survey form indicates whether the property is considered to be a Contributing or Noncontributing element of the Guthrie Historic District or potentially Eligible for individual listing in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). The survey report contains a statement of intent, an introduction, a description of the project goals and methodology, a brief historic context for the project area, and recommendations including

a list of properties that may be individually eligible for NRHP consideration. The report appendices include a comprehensive inventory of the identified properties and separate maps depicting their Contributing and Noncontributing status and approximate dates of construction.

This report is intended as a foundation for preservation planning efforts and Section 106 review in the East Guthrie Townsite. It includes a discussion of the survey and research methods and the survey conclusions. National Register eligibility (Contributing/Noncontributing) assessments are discussed in the Recommendations section. Following the Recommendations section are references and appendices including an inventory of properties surveyed, a map of the survey area depicting Contributing or Noncontributing status of each property and a map showing the approximate ages of each property. In addition to this report, two original sets of photographs, maps and survey forms for each resource are provided; one set to the City of Guthrie and the other to the State Historic Preservation Office. Negatives are filed with the State Historic Preservation Office.

The City of Guthrie participates in the state's Certified Local Government
Program which receives its funding from the U. S. Department of the Interior's Historic
Preservation Fund administered through the State Historic Preservation Office. This
survey, photography, research and report were conducted in accordance with the
Secretary of the Interior's Standards and Guidelines for Identification and Evaluation, and
additional requirements of the City of Guthrie and the Oklahoma State Historic
Preservation Office. The City of Guthrie undertook the project with the cooperation of
the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Office. It was funded in part with federal funds
from the National Park Service, Department of the Interior. All work for the East Guthrie
Townsite Historic Resources Survey was conducted in accordance with the Secretary of
the Interior's Standards and Guidelines and the special requirements of the City of
Guthrie and the State Historic Preservation Office. Preservation Central, Inc., does not
discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin or handicap.

Project Area Boundaries

East Guthrie Townsite is a 98-block, approximately 320-acre urban tract of land that lies wholly within the Guthrie National Register Historic District and partly within the Guthrie National Historic Landmark District. Guthrie is a small city of approximately 10,000 residents about 25 miles north of Oklahoma City. Originally designated the territorial and later the state capital, Guthrie now serves as the seat of Logan County. It is primarily accessed by Interstate 35, which runs on a north-south axis a few miles to the east of the city limits. The project area itself lies at Guthrie's center, east of, and adjacent to, the original Guthrie Townsite, and west of, and adjacent to, the Capitol Hill Townsite. Together with the West Guthrie Townsite, the four areas comprise the historic core of the city of Guthrie, Oklahoma.

The project area follows the boundaries of the East Guthrie Townsite. It is bounded on the north by College Avenue, on the south by a creek running south of Lincoln Avenue, on the west by Division Street and on the east by Walnut Street. The largely residential Townsite contains 849 cultural resources dating from the earliest years of Guthrie's development beginning with the 1889 land run to the present. Of the four original townsites that formed the city of Guthrie in 1889, East Guthrie Townsite is the most heavily populated and most densely intensely developed.

Survey Methods

Previous Surveys in East Guthrie

More than a quarter century has passed since the original cultural resources survey was completed in support of the Guthrie Historic District National Register nomination. Guthrie, Oklahoma contains one of the country's largest and most intact urban historic districts. The district is widely recognized as one of the state's historic treasures and the city has endeavored to maintain its special character through preservation ordinances and by keeping an accurate inventory of the properties that make up the Guthrie Historic District. As part of the city's ongoing preservation program, an update of the 1975 survey was conducted by Jane Thomas, a resident of the East Guthrie Townsite, in 1987. Her documentation is on file at the Oklahoma Territorial Museum. Thomas's work accounted for changes in physical attributes and age status – many properties had reached the recommended 50-year age threshold – since the earlier survey.

In the years following Thomas's 1987 update, as in the preceding period, many changes have taken place within the district. Some properties have been demolished, some restored, and others renovated in ways that obscure or detract from original historic features. New construction has occurred in the district, as well. In addition, many properties that did not meet the recommended 50-year age for Contributing properties in 1975 or 1987, are now eligible for consideration as Contributing elements of the district. Some resources that were 50 years old or older but listed as Noncontributing in 1975 due to alterations, have been renovated or re-evaluated and may now be eligible. Likewise, some properties listed as Contributing in the 1975 survey may have been altered so severely since that time that they no longer convey a sense of history and thus they do not contribute to the district. New properties built since 1955 are also considered Noncontributing. Sufficient change had occurred and time elapsed to warrant a new update of cultural resources.

In January 2002, the City of Guthrie retained Preservation Central Inc. to conduct a comprehensive survey of East Guthrie Townsite, an area encompassing all or part of 98 city blocks and containing more than 800 cultural resources. The current Historic Resources Survey identified and evaluated a total of 849 properties within the East

Guthrie Townsite boundaries for their potential as Contributing or Noncontributing elements of the Guthrie Historic District. The results of that survey are recorded in this report, the accompanying inventory and maps, and in the individual files made for the surveyed properties.

Field Investigations

Field investigations were completed in three survey trips and one additional photographic expedition. Project Director Terri Myers conducted an overview survey to familiarize herself with the properties and the character of the district in February 2002. She began a pedestrian survey at the southernmost end of the project area including properties on Grant and Lincoln avenues, during that trip. She also collected maps and historical information the City of Guthrie and the Oklahoma Territorial Museum to create a field map for the concerted survey effort.

Beginning on March 11, 2002, Ms. Myers supervised two survey crews working in tandem with the intention of completing the survey over a ten-day period. The survey teams included Project Director Terri Myers, Photographer Wayne Pendley, and Field Assistants Brian Eric Pendley, Pam Gipson and Holly Marshall, for Preservation Central, Inc., and Historic Architect Karen McGraw and Architect Troy Miller for McGraw Marburger & Associates. Architectural Historian Lila Knight assisted in the evaluation and description of individual properties once they were surveyed and the photographs processed. Ms. Myers returned to Guthrie in September 3, 2002 to complete the photography and conduct a field check.

The bulk of the survey work was completed in the ten-day period in mid-March, 2003. Ms. Myers supervised the work of both crews and was present throughout the entire survey process. Preservation Central, Inc. consultants Brian Eric Pendley and Pam Gibson, and photographer Wayne Pendley, served on the first survey crew (March 11-17). Karen McGraw, historic architect, and Troy Miller, architect, both of McGraw Marburger and Associates, and Holly Marshall, researcher, formed the second survey crew (March 17-21). Mr. Ronnie Ford, City Planner, provided staff and technical support on behalf of the City of Guthrie. Ms. Myers coordinated her efforts with Mr. Glen

Vaughn-Roberson, Certified Local Government Director, and Jim Gabbert, Architectural Historian, both of the State Historic Preservation Office.

In September 3-6, 2002, Ms. Myers returned to Guthrie to photograph and survey commercial properties not previously recorded and to shoot retakes where necessary. She also field checked the survey map and preservation priorities for selected properties. Finally, Preservation Central associate Amanda Lighty photographed some additional properties in February, 2003.

Survey Methods

Although Ms. Myers conducted some of the survey work on her own, the majority of the work was done by teams with qualified personnel on each crew. The survey crews worked in teams of two with one person photographing properties while the other noted photographic references and recorded the properties' physical attributes on a form designed for this project. All survey work in the East Guthrie Townsite was conducted on foot on a block-by-block basis. At minimum, the team sought to accomplish the following goals:

- to document each individual cultural resource—building, structure, object or site—within the East Guthrie Townsite regardless of age, condition or architectural merit
- to record descriptive information about the property's physical appearance on a Historic Preservation Resource Identification Form
- to identify property locations on a site map
- to take at least two photographs of each resource
- to render preliminary National Register assessments of Contributing or Noncontributing status for each property

East Guthrie Townsite, like its adjacent townsites, follows a strict grid pattern with north-south streets and east-west avenues laid out along the cardinal directions.

Most properties in the district fronted the east-west avenues and north-south streets serve primarily as secondary or local access streets. A notable exception is Division Street, a

major north-south arterial through town that forms the western boundary of the district and project area.

The survey teams documented the east-west streets first, starting at the southern boundary, followed by the north-south streets, starting at the western boundary. Adhering to a strict directional plan reduces the potential to miss properties or duplicate survey efforts. Lighting conditions dictate survey methods to a large degree. When possible, properties on the west sides of north-south streets in the project area were shot in the morning and those on the east sides in the afternoon, to take advantage of the sunlight. Properties on the north and south sides of the east-west avenues were photographed in both morning and afternoon light because the time of day made little difference in the lighting conditions for those properties. Weather proved to be the biggest hurdle in completing the East Guthrie Townsite survey, however. It rained throughout much of the period between March 11 and March 21, 2002, when the survey crews were in Guthrie. As a result, some of the properties, primarily commercial buildings on Oklahoma and Harrison avenues and Division Street, were not surveyed at that time and Ms. Myers returned to Guthrie on September 3, 2002 to complete the task.

Surveyors used Kodak T-Max, ASA 100, black-and-white print film to photograph each resource in the project area. Whenever possible, the surveyors took at least two oblique photographs of each property, capturing three elevations between the two. Additional photographs were sometimes taken of a property's unique or distinguishing features. Major outbuildings were photographed and documented on their own if they had been converted to dwellings. Other noteworthy outbuildings such as garages and other ancillary structures were described on the survey form.

It was not always possible to take two unique photographs due to overgrown vegetation, access or, in the case of some commercial buildings, position. Many of the commercial buildings throughout city share walls with adjacent buildings and only the primary façade can be photographed. In those cases, an attempt was made to include a streetscape view placing the building in its context with adjacent commercial buildings.

In the field, surveyors completed a Historic Preservation Resource
 Identification Form provided by the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation

Office for each resource. The following information was recorded for all properties:

- Address
- Property Type
- Known or Estimated Date of Construction
- Historic and Current Functions
- Areas of Primary and Secondary Significance
- Architectural Style
- Primary and Secondary Exterior Materials
- Roof, Wall, Window and Door Types and Materials

Surveyors used footprint maps based on Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps of the area as field maps to plot the locations and addresses of identified properties. The Sanborn maps used by the survey teams were initially drawn in 1926 and revised in 1948 to reflect then-current conditions. The survey teams compared the 1948 footprint maps to the present resources and noted any changes that had occurred since that time on the field forms. Addresses were also checked against those shown in the Sanborn maps.

Data Encoding and Work Products

Once the field investigations were completed, the information collected on the identification forms was entered into a data base. All of the basic information listed above was encoded along with photographic references to the roll and frame number. City plat maps, Sanborn maps and previous survey research provided the lot and block information encoded in the data base for each resource. Some field information was revised as new information was obtained from research sources such as local histories and Sanborn maps. The data base reflects those revisions.

Architectural descriptions were composed for each resource regardless of age or architectural merit and entered into the data base. Descriptions included the number of stories, basic plan, porch type, decorative or characteristic detailing, alterations, additions and removal of historic fabric. Descriptions of auxiliary buildings, noteworthy landscape

features, and other definitive information was added in the Comments section of the form.

Completed Historic Preservation Resource Identification forms for each property were generated from the data base and inserted into individual legal-sized file folders. Two sets of forms were generated; one for the City of Guthrie and one for the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Office. The file folders were organized alphabetically within street type (avenues first, streets second) and then numerically within each street.

In addition to the survey forms, each folder contains an envelope with 5 x 7-inch black and white photographs showing two different views of the identified property. In most cases, photographs show oblique angles so that the two photographs depict three elevations of a given resource. In some instances, particularly among commercial buildings that abutted one another, only the primary façade was visible to the photographer. In those cases, streetscape photographs were included to show the property's relationship to the other buildings on the block. Labels affixed to the back of the photographs identify the property, its address, view and photographer. Negatives for 59 rolls of film have been inserted into archival sleeves and placed in a three-ring binder with their corresponding contact sheet for storage with the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Office. Identical sets of black-and-white contact sheets and accompanying photo index sheets cross-referenced by roll and address have been submitted to the City of Guthrie and to the State Historic Preservation Office.

Historic Research

The consultant obtained Sanborn Fire Insurance maps corrected to 1948 through Environmental Data Inc. These maps were used to plot resources during the survey. During her first trip to Guthrie, the consultant collected other resource materials from the Oklahoma Territorial Museum including Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps from 1908, 1926 and 1948. A comparison of the Sanborn Maps over the years can help date properties and identify historic additions and alterations. The consultant also copied pertinent information from the 1987 Guthrie Historic District National Register nomination and from the 1999 National Historic Landmark nomination. Secondary source materials were also copied or purchased for later research. Such sources provided contextual

information on the history of the East Guthrie Townsite as well as historic photographs of some resources – primarily commercial buildings – in the project area. Among the books referenced are the Logan County History 1889-1977, Volume II (Holmes 1980), Birth of Guthrie: Oklahoma's Run of 1889 (McGuire 1998) and Guthrie: A History of the Capital City, 18819-1910 (Lentz 1990). These materials enabled the consultant to more accurately assess the surveyed properties from an understanding of their context.

Recommendations

Preservation Central, Inc. identified and documented 849 cultural resources within the East Guthrie Townsite. After field and research investigations were completed, the Project Director reviewed each property and assigned an NRHP eligibility designation based upon its architectural integrity and its known historical associations. Properties were determined to be Contributing or Noncontributing elements of the Guthrie Historic District and are noted as such in the Inventory of Historic Resources. The project area conveys a strong sense of the past and retains a high concentration of relatively unaltered historic properties. Of the 849 properties, 532 were determined to be Contributing and 317 were determined to be Noncontributing elements of the Townsite. Since the National Park Service recommends that districts possess 50 percent Contributing resources, the East Guthrie Townsite easily meets this recommendation.

Individual National Register Properties

Exceptional properties that contribute significantly to local history or broader historic patterns were singled out as potentially eligible for individual listing in the NRHP. Because the Secretary of the Interior Guidelines discourage individual nominations for properties within a designated historic district, only 17 properties were determined to be individually eligible for NRHP listing due to their outstanding architectural or historic significance. They are some of the oldest, rarest or best examples of building forms or architectural styles in Guthrie. They maintain their original architectural fabric to an outstanding degree and exhibit almost no alterations to their exterior appearance. All are Contributing properties within the Guthrie Historic District and are identified as "Individual NR" in the Inventory of Properties in the East Guthrie Townsite. They include the Logan County Courthouse and the Carnegie Library. The following is a list of addresses for properties recommended as individually eligible for NRHP listing:

- 324 South Broad Street 1909 Queen Anne dwelling
- 401 East Cleveland Avenue 1895 Romanesque dwelling
- 624 East Cleveland Avenue ca. 1910 Colonial Revival dwelling

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most noteworthy institutional properties including schools, churches of various denominations, and social halls.

The East Guthrie Townsite is comprised overwhelmingly of historic properties. Its one- and two-story brick and stone commercial buildings are largely limited to historic business corridors of Oklahoma and Harrison avenues although a few front onto Division Street. One of the most intrusive non-historic commercial properties in the district is the Homeland Grocery Store, which is set back from and fronts onto Wentz Street. The project area is replete with historic educational and religious buildings such as schools, churches and a Carnegie library. Many of the churches and one of the schools are along Noble Avenue, a major thoroughfare that is also lined with fine houses. A turn-of-the-century Masonic hall in the townsite is now used for commercial purposes. More recent Masonic buildings constructed in the 1960s also exist in the East Guthrie Townsite. An outstanding governmental building, the Logan County Courthouse, also lies in East Guthrie. East Guthrie is also home to a historic hospital and a Works Progress Administration (WPA) sports stadium and National Guard Armory.

Although it does have its share of commercial and institutional properties, East Guthrie is largely residential in character and it is more intensely developed with domestic properties than the city's three other townsites.

Early Commercial Development

Immediately after the land run, merchants built shops along Oklahoma and Harrison avenues in East Guthrie, as extensions of the commercial streets established in Guthrie proper. Some of these buildings were simple storefronts and none are known to survive in East Guthrie but within a few years, two-story masonry and stone commercial buildings arose on the streets. One of the most outstanding is the Romanesque Revival De Steiger Block built about 1890 and attributed to architect Joseph Foucart. Foucart was responsible for setting the architectural tone of Guthrie's early downtown development and he designed a number of other extant commercial buildings in the Guthrie Historic District.

Beginning about 1900, a major building boom commenced in the city. Within a few years, the 100 and 200 blocks of East Oklahoma and East Harrison avenues were filled with brick and stone commercial buildings, some with fairly elaborate Romanesque Revival, Italianate, and Late Victorian embellishment. Among them are the A.F. & A.M. Lodge-Masonic Hall (1906) at 121 E. Oklahoma, the S.W. Schmidt Building (1904) at 206-208 E. Oklahoma, the Robert Reed Building (1901) at 111 E. Oklahoma and the Oklahoma Building (ca. 1900) at 102-106 E. Oklahoma.

Oklahoma and Harrison avenues remained commercial venues throughout the historic period and, although some newer businesses were introduced in midcentury, most of the historic two-story masonry buildings remained intact. At the same time, Division Street, which separated East and West Guthrie townsites, developed as a north-south highway and it, too, attracted commercial development. Many of the businesses catered to automobile travel and included auto dealerships, service stations and restaurants.

Early Residential Development

At the same time the commercial zone was being developed, homes were under construction throughout the East Guthrie Townsite. Among the earliest houses were simple one-story frame dwellings with porches supported by modestly decorated wooden posts. Examples in East Guthrie include 1 ½ story front-gabled "Homestead" houses, side-gabled center passage houses with full façade front porches, and gable-front and wing dwellings with porches extending across the length of the wing. Most of these modest dwellings are identified as National Folk Houses. A simple gable-front-and-wing National Folk House, built about 1900, is at 708 East Cleveland. Those with decorative brackets, turned porch posts and patterned gable shingles are often identified as Folk Victorian style houses. One such house, also built about 1900, is next door at 710 East Cleveland Avenue. Although a number of these early National Folk and Folk Victorian houses survive in the East Guthrie Townsite, they are more likely to have been altered or to have

suffered from neglect than later or more complex dwellings. They represent the initial settlement efforts of the common people in Guthrie's history.

Even as such modest dwellings appeared throughout the townsite, some residents were busy building elaborate brick and stone showplaces in East Guthrie. During the earliest period of the city's development, the elite residential area of the four townsites was concentrated between Springer Avenue on the south and Noble Avenue on the north (Thomas, 1987). Following the prevailing commercial style, a number of local houses adopted Romanesque architectural designs. Among them are the ca. 1890 Romanesque Revival house at 704 East Warner Avenue and the ca. 1895 Romanesque house attributed to architect Joseph Foucart at 401 East Cleveland Avenue. The Queen Anne style was more popular for domestic architecture, however, and there are many noteworthy Queen Anne and Late Victorian houses in East Guthrie Townsite. Some of the most significant from the earliest period of development are those located at 514 East Noble Avenue (ca. 1895), 701 East Mansur Avenue (ca. 1895), and 324 South Elm Street (ca. 1895).

Early Black Settlement

After the turn of the 20th century, the southern portion of the former silk-stocking residential area fell from favor with Guthrie's elite (Thornas, 1987). Wealthier families tended to live north of Oklahoma Avenue. African Americans moved into the southern end of the East Guthrie Townsite and by 1908, many of Guthrie's African American churches were located in the area. At the southwest corner of Springer Avenue and South Broad Street lay the First Baptist Church. A block south, at the northeast corner of Perkins Avenue and South Broad Street, was the Methodist Episcopal Church. Three blocks to the east, at the northeast corner of East Vilas Avenue and South Elm Street, lay St. Paul's A.M.E. Church. All of these churches continue to maintain a presence in the neighborhood today. Between 1912 and 1917, Faver High School for "colored" students was built at the South Ash Street and East Grant Avenue, one block to the east of South Broad Street. This neighborhood remains largely occupied by African American citizens today, especially from Perkins Avenue south to Lincoln Avenue. Most, although not all, of

the houses in the area are simple one-story, frame dwellings. Some date to the earliest period of settlement in East Guthrie Townsite.

Twentieth Century

By the turn of the 20th century, few building lots remained undeveloped in East Guthrie Townsite. Nearly all had been consumed for commercial construction or housing starts. Two of the most impressive building campaigns that took place in East Guthrie in the early years of the century were not residential or commercial but institutional; the construction of the Carnegie Library in 1902 and the completion of the Logan County Courthouse in 1907. Departures from the dark, almost funereal Romanesque style that characterized the commercial downtown streets and the sometimes frivolous-looking Queen Anne houses that had been so popular in the late 19th century, the Carnegie Library and Logan County Courthouse were stately, classically inspired Beaux Arts masterpieces befitting the territorial, then state, capital.

Following their lead, a number of residential properties in the townsite adopted a more restrained, classical look most evident in Doric or Ionic order porch columns and symmetrical facades. A good example is found at 718 East Warner Avenue (ca. 1905) while two examples of combination Late Victorian/Classical Revival houses are at 619 and 623 East Warner Avenue (ca. 1910). In addition, Colonial Revival styles appeared in the townsite. Two of the most noteworthy are those at 417 North Elm Street (1910) and 624 East Cleveland Avenue (1910).

Despite the removal of the state capital in 1910 to Oklahoma City, which curtailed much of Guthrie's commercial growth, East Guthrie Townsite continued to experience new construction in the 1910s and 1920s. New architectural trends including those stemming from the Arts and Crafts and Prairie School movements found their way to Guthrie. East Guthrie has several good examples of horizontally oriented Prairie-influenced houses. One of the finest is located at 322 East Cleveland Avenue (1910). Much more common are the Craftsman-influenced bungalows found scattered throughout the East Guthrie Townsite. Although they have many variations, most are one-story front-gabled frame dwellings with tapered

posts set on brick piers, paired windows and exposed rafter ends or other exposed structural features. More rare are the so-called Airplane bungalows that feature a partial second story usually set at right angles to the first floor gable. East Guthrie Townsite has excellent examples of both one-story and Airplane bungalows. Near pristine examples of Craftsman-influenced bungalows are at 608 East Warner Avenue (608), 416 East Washington Avenue (1915), and 713 East Vilas Avenue (1920). A good representative example of a 1 ½ story Airplane bungalow can be seen at 501 East Logan Avenue (1920). More residential properties in the East Guthrie Townsite are identified with the Bungalow/Craftsman architectural category than any other style.

While Craftsman-influenced bungalows dominated domestic architecture from the mid-1910s well into the 1930s, Minimal Traditional and Ranch styles emerged toward the end of the historic period. Most of the examples found in the East Guthrie Townsite project dated from the 1940s or 1950s and projected a modern appearance that was not in keeping with the historic character of the district. However, two houses and a small clinic exhibited architectural design and fabric that made them more compatible with their historic surroundings and thus they were considered Contributing elements in the historic district. They are dwellings at 607 and 611 East Logan, built about 1950, and a brick clinic at 221 East Cleveland, built about 1930. Tudor Revival, a very popular domestic style in the 1920s and 1930s elsewhere throughout the country, is completely absent in the East Guthrie Townsite.

Institutional and Governmental Buildings

As East Guthrie Townsite developed into the city's predominant residential district, schools, churches, Masonic halls, and a public library were erected to serve the surrounding populace. Churches of the major Christian denominations including Baptist, Christian, Methodist, Episcopal, Presbyterian and Roman Catholic were all established within a few blocks of one another in East Guthrie by 1908. Noble Avenue was the acknowledged "church row" as so many religious buildings lined the avenue. In addition, the original Central Public School lay at the southwest

corner of North Ash Street and Noble. In 1902, the plans of architect J. H. Bennett were adopted for a classically inspired library funded in part by Andrew Carnegie. Five years later, architect P.H. Weathers designed the Neo-Classical/Beaux Arts Logan County Courthouse, which served as the Oklahoma statehouse until the capital was removed to Oklahoma City in 1910.

Between about 1910 and 1925, many of the area's churches and schools were replaced with more modern buildings. The ecclesiastical architecture tends to follow modest Gothic Revival or Romanesque traditions. Some good examples are the First United Presbyterian Church (1926) at 106 East Noble Avenue, First United Methodist Church (1910) at 220 East Noble Avenue, and the Episcopal Church (1910) at 302 East Noble Avenue. The former Guthrie High School (1925) also exhibits Late Gothic Revival features and can be seen at 711 East Oklahoma Avenue. One of the last institutions to be built in the East Guthrie Townsite during the historic period was the new Central School at 317 East Noble Avenue. Built in 1930, the present building replaced the original school on the site.

Public Works During the Great Depression

Guthrie's economy was maintained through oil revenues during the 1920s but when oil prices plummeted in 1930, growth and development came to a virtual standstill. Little construction occurred in East Guthrie Townsite throughout the Great Depression with the exception of several notable Works Progress Administration (WPA) projects – the National Guard Armory on Logan Avenue and Jelsma Field and Stadium between Harrison and Vilas avenues. The stadium is a typical, simple WPA recreational facility comprised of stone seats in an ampitheater-like setting with small stone ticket booths at the entrances. The National Guard Armory, however, is an imposing fortress-like stone structure with a crenelated parapet wall. Built in 1936, it is listed in the National Register of Historic Places and is located in the 700 block of East Logan Avenue.

Another area that benefited from public monies during the Great Depression was the African American community in the southern sector of East Guthrie Townsite. Page School, a large U-shaped brick elementary school and auditorium

designated for "colored" children (demolished), was built in 1937 at the northeast corner of South Broad Street and East Grant Avenue. A few years earlier, in 1933, a gymnasium had been built next to the "colored" high school (Faver High School built 1912-1917, demolished). The high school and auditorium lay on the south side of East Grant Street across from the Page School playground. The gymnasium is the only surviving feature of school complex. It has a slightly curved parapet and inset patterned brick reminiscent of the Mission Revival style. The building is located at 313 East Grant Avenue. Although there are no longer separate schools in the neighborhood, numerous churches throughout the southern sector of East Guthrie Townsite continue to serve a still vital African American community.

Current Trends

New construction in East Guthrie Townsite didn't resume until after World War II, and then only occasionally as one of the few vacant lots was made available or an old house was torn down. East Guthrie Townsite's building stock largely reflects its early, intensive development and relative resistance to later redevelopment. Of the 849 cultural resources surveyed in this effort, 762 were built before 1955 and the majority of those – 486 – were built before 1919. Of the total number of historic properties, 532 retained sufficient historic fabric to be considered Contributing elements of the Guthrie Historic District.

East Guthrie's large concentration of intact, historic properties — from the National Guard Armory and the old Rock Island Depot to the grand houses along Noble Avenue, and the small bungalows and Folk Victorians scattered throughout the townsite — strongly identifies the townsite with the city's historic past.

Historically, the area provided schools, churches, a commercial district, a library, the county courthouse, a WPA stadium and armory and, most importantly, homes. East Guthrie Townsite continues to meet these needs for the city, and in the original — now historic — buildings.
