XIII. PROPERTIES WITH NATIONAL REGISTER POTENTIAL

During the course of the Western Oklahoma Grain

Elevator Survey, some 116 properties (plus two from Oklahoma

County) were identified that had National Register

potential. That conclusion was reached after evaluating the

different properties according to criteria established by

the National Register of Historic Places. Specifically,

each property was at least 50 years old; it was intricately

associated with the historically and architecturally

significant events described in Section II, "Historical

Context"; and it retained integrity of location, design,

setting, materials, workmanship, feeling, and association.

Put differently, the properties were constructed before or

during 1941, were a part of the historic evolution of grain

elevators on the Great Plains, and had not been altered in

design, site or materials.

Grain elevator properties in Western Oklahoma with
National Register potential are set out below. They are
listed separately by material and functional type, with all
lists arranged by counties. Included are A) "Wood Country
Elevators with National Register Potential," B) "Tile
Country Elevators with National Register Potential," C)
"Concrete Country Elevators with National Register
Potential," D) "Terminal Elevators with National Register
Potential," and E) "Flour Mills and Elevators with National
Register Potential." A regional map showing location of

each property by type is supplied (Maps D through H).

Provided too is a combined list of all properties with


National Register potential, regardless of type.

The Western Oklahoma Grain Elevator Survey also documented properties that had National Register potential in every aspect with the exception of age. This occurred because the parameters of the survey included elevators constructed before 1950. At least 83 properties fell into this category, i.e. were constructed between 1942 and 1950, retained architectural integrity, and had historical significance. As each reaches 50 years of age, or comes "on line" as it were, presumably they too would warrant consideration for inclusion on the National Register of Historic Places. These properties are listed below, with property type and function designated by code, in "Combined List of Properties with National Register Potential during the Course of the Next Decade (1990s)." Their age may be discerned by consulting Appendix B, entitled "Western Oklahoma Grain Elevators By Date of Construction."

Of the 242 properties documented during the course of the Western Oklahoma Grain Elevator Survey (244 if properties in Oklahoma County are included), at least 41 were deemed to not warrant further consideration for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places. All met the 50 year criteria, and all related to the historical and architectural development of grain elevators on the

Great Plains. Most, however, had been so altered or been permitted to deteriorate to the point that they had lost much of their design and structural integrity. Still others were not determined worthy of further consideration because they were already on the National Register of Historic Places, e.g. some tile and wood elevators, as well as Okeene Milling Company elevators. Properties that should not be or that need not be given additional study are set out in section H below, "Properties That Warrant No Further National Register Consideration." Included in this category too are the 308 sites mentioned previously in Section XII where no structure of any kind was found by the surveyor.

- Banham, Peter. A Concrete Atlantis: U.S. Industrial
 Building and European Modern Architecture, 1900-1925.
 Cambridge: MIT Press, 1986.
- _____. "Catacombs of the Modern Movement," Archetype 1 (Winter, 1980): 43-47.

Banham is one of the few architectural historians who has written about grain elevators. Although his work is primarily concerned with terminal elevators in the east and midwest, most of it is still relevant to the concrete terminal and country elevators found in Oklahoma.

Blood, K. D., and Marjorie Lee Hill. Wheat Production in Oklahoma, 1894-1938 in Agricultural Experiment Station Circular #92. Stillwater: Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College, 1941.

This study provides an excellent introduction to the development of wheat culture in Oklahoma.

- Bourland, Heber Dean. A Small Country Elevator for Merchandising Grain. U.S. Dept. of Agriculture Marketing Research Report #387. Washington, D. C.: USDA, 1960.
 - . <u>Locating, Designing, and Building</u>
 <u>Country Grain Elevators. Agriculture Information</u>
 <u>Bulletin #310. Washington, D. C.: USDA, 1966.</u>

Bourland's two bulletins are somewhat technical but both are vitally important to understanding the internal workings of a country elevator as of the late 1950s.

"Buffalo's Mighty Elevators Set for District Status,"

<u>Society for Industrial Archeology Newsletter</u>. 15
(Summer 1986): 8-9.

This brief article is little more than a news item, but it demonstrates the increased attention preservationists are giving grain elevators.

Burrill, Meredith. A Socio-Economic Atlas of Oklahoma. Stillwater: Oklahoma A & M Experiment Station, 1936.

Burrill provides excellent maps relating to Oklahoma's agriculture during the mid-1930s.

Clark, William C. The Country Elevator in the Canadian West. Kingston, Ontario: The Jackson Press, 1916.

Although this study relates to Canada, it demonstrates that the Canadian experience was quite similar to that of the southern Great Plains, especially in the tension between line elevators and wheat producers.

Columbia University. <u>Avery Index to Architectural</u> <u>Periodicals</u>. Boston: G. K. Hall & Co., 1963-1988.

This is an invaluable reference work to architectural periodical literature. It directed me to sources that I would not have found anywhere else.

Crawford, R. P. "Moving Forms For Concrete Elevators,"
Scientific American 117 (Sept. 1, 1917): 115.

This contemporary account, or primary source, gives considerable insight into the slip-forms that made construction of cylindrical, concrete elevators possible.

Dart, Joseph. "The Grain Elevators of Buffalo: A Paper Read Before the Buffalo Historical Society Club, March 13, 1865." <u>Buffalo Historical Society Publications</u>. Vol 1. Buffalo: Bigelo Brothers, 1879.

> This is the principal primary source relating to the application of the elevator technology to moving grain vertically in bulk.

Dines, Frederic T. Quality of Wheat Varieties Grown in Oklahoma in 1938 in Agricultural Experiment Station Circular #85. Stillwater: Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College, 1939.

Dines's bulletin is a primary source for comprehending the varieties of wheat grown in Oklahoma and how those different varieties related to the national market.

Farlow, Lawrence. The Farmers Elevator Movement in Illinois. Farmers Grain Dealers Association of Illinois, 1928.

This is an excellent monograph that provides important historical information about the cooperative elevator movement and thus background for the Oklahoma story.

Fegles Construction Company. The Business of Building Grain Elevators. Minneapolis: n.p., c. 1931.

A primary source that relates to elevator construction. Fegles, however, constructed no known elevator in Oklahoma.

- Fite, Gilbert C. <u>The Farmers' Frontier, 1865-1900</u>.

 Reprint. Albuquerque: University of New Mexico Press, 1977.
- . Farm to Factory: A History of the Consumer Cooperative Association. Columbia: University of Missouri Press, 1965.

Dr. Fite's two books are invaluable sources for understanding the farmer cooperative movement in Oklahoma.

"Fireproof Steel and Brick Grain Elevators at Buffalo," Scientific American 77 (Dec. 25, 1897): 401, 407.

This contemporary source helps date the early usage of steel plate in constructing grain elevators, a material widely employed in Oklahoma after statehood.

Fornari, Harry D. "Recent Developments in the American Grain Storage Industry," <u>Agricultural History</u> 56 (Jan. 1982): 264-271.

Fornari provides some interesting details about the development of the grain elevator industry, although he does not deal with Oklahoma specifically.

Green, Donald E., "Beginnings of Wheat Culture in Oklahoma,"
Rural Oklahoma, ed. by Donald E. Green. Oklahoma City:
Oklahoma Historical Society, 1977.

This noted Oklahoma historian provides here a path-breaking and essential account of early wheat production in Oklahoma Territory.

Hall, Thomas Elliot. New Country Elevators. Circular #10. Washington, D. C.: USDA Farmers Cooperative Service, 1955.

This technical bulletin of the USDA gives a good description of country elevators as of the mid-1950s.

"Handling and Storage of Our Huge Grain Crop," <u>Scientific</u>
<u>American</u> 101 (Dec. 11, 1909): 444-45, 451-53.

This primary source supplies important general information on the history of the grain elevator industry in the United States in general.

"Handling the Grain Crop at the Port of New York,"
Scientific American 77 (Nov. 20, 1897): 325-26.

Another primary source, this story provides firsthand information on the grain trade in the United States.

Hedges, Harold. Operations of Cooperative Grain Elevators in Kansas and Oklahoma, 1931-32 to 1936-37. Bulletin #30. Washington, D. C.: Farm Credit Administration, 1939.

To fully understand the cooperative movement in Oklahoma as applied to grain elevators, this study is invaluable.

Hofsommer, Donovan. <u>Katy Northwest</u>. Boulder: Pruett Publishing Co., 1976.

_______, ed. <u>Railroads in Oklahoma</u>. Oklahoma City: Oklahoma Historical Society, 1977.

Hofsommer probably knows more about Oklahoma railroads than most students of the subject. These two books provide general information as to dates of construction and some details on the controversies between railroad and farmers that led to the cooperative movement.

Isern, Thomas. <u>Custom Combining on the Great Plains</u>. Norman: University of Oklahoma Press, 1981.

This is an innovative study that relates more to the general story of wheat production that to grain elevators.

Jackson, Keith. E. <u>Grain Elevator Dust Explosions</u>. Springfield, Ill.: Illinois Legislative Council, 1979.

Dust explosions in grain elevators was a constant danger. Although this study relates primarily to Illinois, it enables one to understand the problem as it pertained to Oklahoma. Kenkel, Joseph B. The Cooperative Elevator Movement: A
Study of Graining Marketing at Country Points in the
North Central States. Washington: Catholic University
of America, 1922.

A doctoral dissertation, this is the standard study of the cooperative elevator movement in the United States. Unfortunately, it deals only with the north central states.

Ketchum, Milo Smith. The Design of Walls, Bins, and Grain Elevators. New York: McGraw-Hill Book Co., 1919.

Ketchum provides in this much revised book an engineering manual for the construction of grain elevators. For the contractor and the architectural student, it was the bible.

Kline, John J., et al. <u>The Oklahoma Economy</u>. Stillwater: Department of Economics, College of Business, Oklahoma State University, 1963.

Provides important statistical information on wheat production in specific and agriculture in general in Oklahoma.

Kraenzel, Carl F. <u>The Great Plains in Transition</u>. Norman: University of Oklahoma Press, 1955.

A good secondary study of the changing agricultural conditions on the Great Plains.

MacKenzie, Robert C. "Prairie Elevators 'Go To Town'," Canadian Geography 98 (Jan., 1979): 52-57.

> A glimpse of Canadian elevators that speaks to their importance in fostering a sense of place.

McEvoy, D. "Elevator and Modern Granaries," <u>Canadian</u> Magazine 21 (July 1903): 204-09.

Another glimpse of Canadian elevators and their role in modern society.

Malin, James C. <u>Winter Wheat in the Golden Belt of Kansas:</u>
A Study in Adaption to Subhumid Geographical
Environment. Lawrence: University of Kansas Press,
1944.

Any serious student of wheat culture in the Great Plains will want to read this book.

"Milling in Oklahoma," American Miller 68 (Feb. 1940):81-82.

Only a brief sketch of flour milling in Oklahoma, this article is not as important as a source of information as the magazine itself. A national trade journal, <u>American Miller</u> from time to time, especially before World War II gave news of events in Oklahoma.

"Modern Grain Elevators," <u>Scientific American</u> 85 (Aug. 24, 1901): 117.

This is a primary source that describes contemporary developments in the grain elevator industry.

Oklahoma Agricultural Experiment Station. A Statistical Handbook of Oklahoma Agriculture. Experiment Station Misc. Pub. #P-14. Stillwater: Okla. Ag. Exp. Station, 1949.

Here is THE source for agricultural statistics in Oklahoma.

Oklahoma State Board of Agriculture. <u>Annual Report for 1951</u>. Oklahoma City: State Board of Agriculture, 1952.

The annual reports of the State Board of Agriculture are invaluable primary sources for the history of Sooner State Agriculture.

Oklahoma Farmer-Stockman.

This is a little known, but extremely important primary source for understanding the history of agriculture in Oklahoma. Its long-time editor, Carl Williams, was extremely influential in promoting the cooperative and wheat pool movements in Oklahoma. The publication is on microfilm at the State Historical Society.

<u>Okla.: Oklahoma Grain and Feed Dealers Association,</u> 1927, 1939, 1940, and 1989.

This document enables the researcher to determine where elevators operated in Oklahoma and who owned them. I used the 1940 edition to establish the basic list of properties included in the survey.

Patton, Harold Smith. <u>Grain Growers Cooperation in Western</u> <u>Canada</u>. Cambridge: Harvard University Press, 1928.

Although pertinent to Canada primarily, this monograph provides needed background information on the cooperative aspect of the grain trade in Oklahoma.

Proceedings of Conference of Men Engaged in Grain Dust Explosion and Fire Prevention Campaign. New York, 1920.

A primary source, this document illustrates the concern of the industry relative to grain dust explosions, a concern that did not impact Oklahoma until widespread construction of concrete elevators occurred in the 1930s.

Portland Cement Association. Concrete Grain Bins and Elevators. Chicago: Portland Cement Assn., 1917.

A promotional pamphlet for concrete elevators, this primary document suggests that cement came to be accepted as a building material for elevators only slowly.

- Refsell, O. N. "Farmer's Elevator Movement, I," <u>Journal of Political Economy</u> 22 (Nov. 1914): 872-95.
- . "Farmer's Elevator Movement, II," <u>Journal of</u>
 <u>Political Economy</u> 22 (Dec. 1914): 969-991.

Refsell's two articles provided excellent background material on the farmer's elevator movement that played such an important role in Oklahoma during the 1920s and 1930s. Riley, Robert B. "Grain Elevators: Symbol of Time, Place and Honest Building," <u>AIA Journal</u> 66 (Nov. 1977): 50-55.

Riley is the only professional architect that I know currently that has written on grain elevators. His concern is principally elevators in the midwest and Canada, but much of what he says is applicable to western Oklahoma.

Rodine, Floyd. "Legislative and Legal Struggles of the Grain Cooperatives in Nebraska, 1900-1915," Nebraska History 56 (Winter, 1975): 457-470.

Although he deals particularly with Nebraska, Rodine also provides an insight to the legal difficulties of grain cooperatives in general.

Schlebecker, John T. Whereby We Thrive: A History of American Farming, 1607-1972. Ames: Iowa State University Press, 1975.

This is the standard, general history of agriculture in the United States.

Shorthill, John. <u>Management of Country Elevators</u>. Chicago: The American Institute of Agriculture, 1922.

This pamphlet gives advise to novice farmers on how to manage their cooperative grain elevators. It demonstrates that good management was a rarity at a very early date, a problem that continues to plague them.

Smith, G. E. Kidder. The Architecture of the United States:

Volume 3, The Plains States and Far West. Garden City,
N.Y.: Anchor Press/Doubleday, 1981.

This is a most important reference work that describes significant architectural properties in each state. It is arranged by town. There are several entries on particular grain elevators.

Steel Storage and Elevator Construction Company. Fireproof Elevators that pay for themselves. Buffalo, N.Y.: Steel Storage and Elevator Construction Company, 190?.

This is an interesting primary source that helps date the use of steel in elevator construction.

Storck, John and Walter Dorwin Teague. Flour for Man's Bread: A History of Milling. Minneapolis: Univ. of Minnesota Press, 1952.

An excellent monograph on the history of flour milling, a significant industry in Oklahoma and very much a part of the grain elevator story.

"Transportation of Grain in the United States," <u>Scientific</u>
<u>American</u> 65 (Oct. 24, 1891): 255, 258, 261.

This is a primary source that gives considerable insight as to how grain was transported in the nation as a whole.

United States, Dept. of Interior. Annual Report of the Governor of Oklahoma, 1897, 1898, 1899 and 1901. Washington, D. C.: GPO, 1898.

A federal government document, this publication provides basic information on wheat culture, grain elevators and flour milling during Oklahoma territorial era. It is THE source for the period prior to 1907 and after 1889.

"What Happens in a Grain Elevator?" <u>Scientific American</u> 148 (April 1933): 226-7.

An interesting early discussion of the internal workings of a grain elevator.

Wilson, C. F. A Century of Canadian Grain: Government
Policy to 1951. Saskatoon: Western Producer Prairie
Books, 1978.

This study provides comparative information on governmental policy affecting grain elevators.

USDA yearbooks are basic sources on the history of agriculture in America. This particular volume speaks to the organization of farmer cooperatives in Oklahoma.

XV. SUMMARY

The Western Oklahoma Grain Elevator Survey was conducted by Pepperdine University, Malibu, California, during the year 1989-1990 under contract with the Oklahoma Historical Society. W. David Baird acted as Principal Investigator.

The objective of the project was to survey at an intensive level all grain elevators in a 32 county area constructed before 1950. Desiring to emphasize "historical significance" as defined by the National Register of Historic Places, the PI identified 490 grain elevator operators doing business in the study area as of 1940. These properties were then visited during May and June, as well as August, 1990, to determine their current status.

Of the properties originally listed, 308 had no grain elevator currently associated with it. When an elevator did exist, it was appropriately documented, especially if it was constructed in 1940 or before. Altogether, some 242 grain elevators constructed prior to 1951 were documented (plus two more from Oklahoma County). Some 118 of these, including those in Oklahoma County, warrant further investigation for possible nomination to the National Register of Historic Places. As they come "on line" over the next decade, 83 other elevators constructed during the 1940s will also have National Register potential. Forty-one of the properties, because of loss of architectural

integrity and structural deterioration and because they are already recognized by the register, warrant no further study by the SHPO.

The survey not only documented specific properties. It also enabled the PI to derive some important conclusions as to the historical and architectural significance of grain elevators in western Oklahoma. Those are detailed in Section IX above, along with a further comment by architectural historian David Gebhard of the University of California, Santa Barbara. Suffice it to say, the PI discerned that grain elevators provide a visual landscape that makes western Oklahoma distinctive from the rest of the state and contributes to a profound "sense of place" that affects visitors and residents alike.
