- Application form
- Narrative history with documentation on 8.5"x11" white paper, double-spaced and clearly printed with one-inch margins and a minimum type size of 12 point
- Written approval of the landowner, if applicable
- Photograph of the recommended location
- United States Geological Survey map with the proposed location marked
- Suggested wording for the marker (200-word maximum)
- An image for etching into a granite marker, if applicable
