### **2008.116 Children of the Confederacy Scrapbook**

This scrapbook of Confederate history was compiled by the Children of the Confederacy, May Siddons Phillips Chapter of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, in 1935. It contains primarily newspaper articles, some images, and original writings such as “A Drummer Boy of Shiloh,” by Vic Reinhart.

### **2012.094 The Collection of the United Daughters of the Confederacy, Oklahoma Division**

The bulk of this collection is applications for membership in the Oklahoma Division of the United Daughters of the Confederacy and the Children of the Confederacy. Applications for the Cross of Service, Military Cross of Service, Southern Cross of Honor, and the Confederate Cross of Honor are also in the collection. A limited number of chapter-related documents are included, as are several chapter scrapbooks.

### **2007.074 United Daughters of the Confederacy, General Clement A. Evans Chapter #1204 Collection**

Contains membership files and obituaries of deceased members

### **2010.049 United Daughters of the Confederacy, Davis-Lee Chapter #2080**

The United Daughters of the Confederacy (UDC), Davis-Lee Chapter 2080 Collection contains records from the organization based in Stillwater, Oklahoma. Meeting minutes (1955–66), as well as conference proceedings from 1940 to 1949, are included. The Davis-Lee Chapter 2080 was a chapter of UDC from 1935 to 2007. Former members of the chapter gave their chapter material to the Chapter President of General Robert Edward Lee 2127 for donation to a suitable location.

### **2009.034 United Daughters of the Confederacy, Oklahoma City Chapter #1181**

This collection includes a scrapbook of events and member activities in 1984–85, typewritten speeches of Lucyl Shirk, and a certificate establishing the Mildred Lee Chapter no. 4 of the Children of the Confederacy Oklahoma City Chapter #1181 dated 1931.

### **[No Number] Daughters of the American Revolution Collection**

This collection contains scrapbooks and materials on the state DAR room.

### **2013.429 Daughters of Union Veterans of the Civil War Collection**

The Daughters of Union Veterans of the Civil War collection contains membership applications of chapters that are no longer active. An index to these applications is available on the Oklahoma Historical Society website.

### **2009.158 National Ladies Auxiliary Veterans of World War I Collection**

The National Ladies Auxiliary Veterans of World War I collection contains county records of the alumni and descendants of the World War I National Ladies Auxiliary.

Contains 89ers Association Organization records (1970s–80s). Includes financial data, correspondence, and membership information.
