

## Guide to Manuscript Collections | Space and Astronauts

### **2008.124 Cobb, Jerrie**

This collection contains newspaper clippings, magazine articles, correspondence, and biographical information on Jerrie Cobb.

### **1980.011 Elliot, Jerry**

Contains documents concerning the American Indian heritage and the NASA career of Jerry C. Elliott. Also includes extensive documentation of the Apollo space program, Skylab, and the Space Shuttle program.

### **Historic Oklahoma**

Historic Oklahoma is a vertical file of original materials. The collection is arranged alphabetically by topic and includes a biographical series.

### **2007.190 Kirkpatrick Science and Air Space Museum Collections**

The Kirkpatrick Science and Air Space Museum Collections contain various items that were transferred from the Kirkpatrick Air and Space Museum (now Science Museum Oklahoma). Included is correspondence, biographical information, ephemera and memorabilia, and newsletters relating to the space program.

### **2008.057 NASA Collection**

The NASA Collection includes several booklets from the years 2007–2008, including the *Spinoff*, a yearly publication which also has a CD of the magazine. There are several large posters in the collection, one with the pictures of the astronauts from the year 2007, and one of an exhibit from the space museum in Alabama. There is also a folder of NASA history, with a brief introduction to the space program and some of its accomplishments, a folder of photocopied pictures from NASA and some of its astronauts, and a booklet on Electron Beam Melting. The largest folder is a printout of biographies of astronauts from Oklahoma.

### **2010.062 Shirley, Donna**

The Donna Shirley Collection consists of the papers of Donna Shirley from 1910–2006. The papers include correspondence, scrapbooks, reports from the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, work notebooks and manuscripts. The collection documents Shirley's personal life as well as her achievements with NASA and the University of Oklahoma. The collection is well documented from the 1950s through the 1990s. The scrapbooks cover all four years of Shirley's college career and social activities during that time. The late 1990s through the 2000s lack information about her social activities and business correspondence but contain newspaper articles pertaining to Mars exploration and the problems with the rovers. The collection has a wide variety of information about all of the projects that Shirley worked on with NASA.

### **2012.052 Space Program Scrapbook Collection**

Contains a scrapbook with newspaper clippings of the NASA space program from 1957 to 1965.

### **2013.131 Tate, Jerod**

Autographed prints of photos of astronauts including Joe Engle, Richard Truly, Fullerton, Haise Jr., Carr, Gibson, Pogue, etc. Numerous book publications of Apollo flight procedures, data booklets, Apollo 8 flight plan book, preliminary flight plan manuals dated 4-15-1969, landing deceleration manuals, tanks training manuals, into to space, telemetry manuals, and NASA Fact sheets. Collection has water damage.
