

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
SUBMITTED TO THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION
Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 800.6(a)

Whereas, the Department of the Air Force has determined that demolition will have an effect upon Building 236, a property potentially eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places, and has consulted with the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) pursuant to 36 CFR, Part 800, regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 USC 470f).

Now, therefore, the Department of the Air Force and the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Officer agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulation in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

STIPULATION

The Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Officer shall consider the Historic Preservation Resource Identification Form, black and white photos and blueprints already submitted to be sufficient documentation.

Documentation of this Memorandum of Agreement by the Department of the Air Force and the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Officer, its subsequent acceptance by the Council, and implementation of its terms, evidence that the Department of the Air Force has afforded the Council an opportunity to comment on the demolition and its effects on historic properties, and that the Department of the Air Force has taken into account the effects of the undertaking on historic places.
