

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

FILED WITH THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION  
PURSUANT TO 36 CFR § 800.6(a)

WHEREAS, the City of Oklahoma City has determined that work begun on the Greenlease-Moore Chevrolet Company Building, at 327 Dean A. McGee Avenue (also addressed as 400 North Walker Avenue), in Oklahoma City, will have an effect upon the building, an individual resource for its architectural significance and for its association with the historical development of the proposed Civic Center Historic District of Oklahoma City, thus is eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places, and has consulted with the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation officer (SHPO), pursuant to 36 CFR Part 800, regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470f);

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Oklahoma City and the Oklahoma SHPO agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulation in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

STIPULATION

Greenlease-Moore Chevrolet Company Building  
327 Dean A. McGee Avenue or 400 North Walker Avenue  
Oklahoma City, Oklahoma

The City of Oklahoma City will ensure that the following recordation measure is carried out in consultation with the Oklahoma SHPO.


Measure:

Documentation consisting of Historic Preservation Resource Identification Forms and photographs of the property.

Execution of this Memorandum of Agreement by the City of Oklahoma City and the Oklahoma SHPO, its subsequent filing with the Council, and implementation of its terms evidence that the City of Oklahoma City has afforded the Council an opportunity to comment on the work on the Greenlease-Moore Chevrolet Company Building, and its effects on historic properties, and that the City of Oklahoma City has taken into account the effects of the undertaking on historic properties.
