

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

SUBMITTED TO THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION
PURSUANT TO 36 CFR 800.6(a)

WHEREAS the City of Oklahoma City has determined that rehabilitation of the Riverside School, 421 Southwest 11th, Oklahoma City will have an effect upon the building, an individual resource which for its architectural significance and for its association with the historical development of education in Oklahoma City is eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places, and has consulted with the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) pursuant to 36 CFR Part 800, regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S. C. 470f);

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Oklahoma City and the Oklahoma SHPO agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulation in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

STIPULATIONS



The City of Oklahoma City will insure that the following measures are carried out:


The City of Oklahoma City recorded the Riverside School Building, 421 Southwest 11th, in accordance with the Oklahoma SHPO's minimum documentation standards outlined in its publication entitled Review and Compliance Manual (December 1992). The City of Oklahoma City, prior to the beginning of rehabilitation work on the Riverside School Building, 421 Southwest 11th, shall consult with the Oklahoma SHPO to determine the additional photographs, to be prepared in accordance with Review and Compliance Manual (December 1992) for recordation of the building's significant interior spaces and provide these photographs as supplementary material to the documentation on file with the Oklahoma SHPO.

Execution of this Memorandum of Agreement by the City of Oklahoma City and the Oklahoma SHPO, its subsequent acceptance by the Council, and implementation of its items, evidence that the City of Oklahoma City has afforded the Council an opportunity to comment on the rehabilitation of the Riverside School Building, 421 Southwest 11th, and its effects on historic properties, and that the City of Oklahoma City has taken into account the effects of this undertaking on historic properties.
